

# Pastor's Ponderings





Second, the last two weeks with my family has helped me put time in perspective. I'm talking about the quick passage of time, I'm not talking about plans for leaving exactly. I am recognizing the fact that I intended to stay here for 10 years and it always seemed far off. However, 10 years is the end of May, 2028, two and three quarters years from now. Time is moving too fast to ignore that fact.

Why bring this up now? Because we have an opportunity to use the time we have together to move our congregations to a place where you will feel confident that whatever the future holds, you will be prepared to carry out Christ's ministry, regardless. That is not something to put off until later. With Covid, a change of pastors, floods, fires, and the joining of two ministries, we have not spent the time we need focusing on where Christ is leading us. We see less people on Sunday and general giving is down. This is not just happening here, but still, it is happening HERE. Looking forward, interim periods tend to make that worse. It is something we need to pay attention to sooner rather than later.

My goal has always been in my mission statement, now smudged with soot, on the door of my office. "As a called and ordained minister of the church of Christ, and with his help, I will: enable, encourage, empower, and equip, God's people for ministry and mission." It is always about God's work through you.

Pastor's are here for a while and we are blessed to be able love you through the best and worst times in a congregation's life—doubly blessed for two- but the church is you, the priesthood of believers called through the Holy Spirit to this place. I am invigorated by the possibilities for the next two+ years. If the last 8 months is an indicator, it will go quickly. I hope the possibilities reminds each of us that we aren't called to wait and see what happens, but to be Christ's hands and feet in this place for generations to come.
