When I was a kid there was one thing you could count on when I woke up in the morning, I started every day with a healthy dose of Captain Kangaroo. Bunny Rabbit, Mr. Moose, and Dancing Bear, were my friends, as was Mr. Greenjeans and all the other characters of this long running series. Not that I was exclusivist, Romper Room, The Funny Company, and catchy commercials (Oh, I wish I was and Oscar Meyer Weiner...) all hold a special place in my heart, but Captain Kangaroo was my generations' Mr. Rogers. (Not surprisingly, they were friends and fellow advocates for children and children's educational television, even appearing on each other's shows.)

I think what made him and his show so special, was that he and his castmates told stories that helped us learn about life and values in a down to earth way that was fun and easy to understand, sometime in the form of actual storybooks.

One story that I loved, was "Stone Soup." Now, I have discovered that this is a very old European folktale and there are many versions of it, but the one that he would read was by Marcia Brown (Athenium books for young readers). 

St. Mark's Adult Bible Study class, formerly, Martha's Circle-WELCA, whas resumed meeting at St. Mark's .Thanks be to God!


Meetings are the first Wednesday of each month at 2pm. It is open to everyone.
