

Pastor's Ponderings

No one after lighting a lamp puts it under the bushel basket, but on the lampstand, and it gives light to all in the house. In the same way, let your light shine before others, so that they may see your

good works and give glory to your Father in heaven." Matthew 5:15-16.

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

As we travel through the weeks of Easter and beyond, we travel with the risen Christ, the light in our darkness, the true light that came into the world.

This verse speaks to the heart of discipleship. Walking in the light of Jesus necessarily means we reflect his light to all we encounter on his way. A story goes— "A little boy once heard his Sunday School teacher say Jesus was the light of the world. He took her remark quite literally. After class, the boy said to his teacher, "If Jesus really is the light of the world, I wish He'd come hang out in my alley. It's awfully dark where I live."

Truth is, no matter how nice our neighborhoods are, it can be "awful dark" in all of them. Being disciples, students and followers, we are called on to reflect the light we have received in our baptisms, the meal, the Word, beyond the walls of the building and even within them.

As we enter the summer months filled with activities and vacations, don't let the flame die back. Come to church here or wherever to bask for a little while in his light so that your light continues to shine while you are away. There is an awful lot of darkness out there even in broad daylight.
